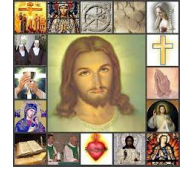
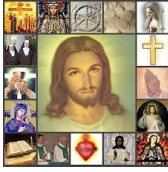


## Welcome to Mrs. Lunn's Religion Class!!!!

### Class Rules:

**Be Respectful.** Show respect for all people and property.

**Be Responsible Prepared and On Task.** Bring required homework, planner, and all materials and be on time to class everyday!

**Be a Good Citizen and Follow Directions.** Please do what you are asked to do the first time! For your safety it is very important to follow the safety and lab guidelines.

**Be Trustworthy and Honest.** Cheating is not tolerated. If a student is caught cheating they will receive a zero on the test, lab, or homework. (This includes the persons giving and/or receiving answers)

**Be Caring and Positive.**

### If you choose to follow or not follow the rules the consequences are as follows:

#### Positive:

1. Praise from the teacher or peers
2. Permission to participate in field trips and class activities/games

#### Negative:

1. 1st time = Verbal Warning
2. 2nd time or repeat offense = Referral to assistant principal & parent - teacher - student meeting  
\*I will email home to inform parents when a conduct referral is given\*

**A severe disruption will result in an immediate referral!**

### Required Materials:

### Quizzes and Tests:

There will be weekly quizzes on Engrade. These quizzes will be every Thursday during homeroom and taken in the Computer lab. There will also be Unit Tests. These will be Essay Tests using Claim, Data, Warrant.

### Wax Museum:

In May students will participate in a Wax Museum dressing up as their favorite Saint. This is a yearlong culmination project celebrating the Saints of our Church. Students will be required to research a Saint of their choice and give a two minute presentation telling of the Saints life and dress as though they were that Saint during the time period when their Saint walked among us. (More details will be disseminated as the year progresses)

**Homework Policy:**

All work that is turned in should have a proper heading (*first and last name, date, grade level- in the upper right hand corner*). It is **very** important that you turn your work in on time! Assignments without a name will not earn credit and may be discarded. Any work not completed in class will be considered homework. Homework assignments are given daily and will only receive credit if they are completed by the beginning of class on the due date.

**Late/Absent Work:**

If you are absent one day, you have one day to turn in late work with no penalty. You have as many days as you are absent to turn in your work. You are responsible for contacting your teachers to find out which assignments you have missed and the extension deadline for this material. You will receive a zero for any work not turned in. If you missed a lab day you will be required to write me a report/essay on the subject matter that was learned in class that day. I will not accept any unexcused late work. I will not accept any absent work that is not turned in by the extension deadline.

**Extra Credit:**

Extra Credit is meant to enhance student learning, not to replace class work. Only a few extra credit opportunities will be offered throughout the year. Please do not depend on these assignments to boost your religion grade.

**Volunteer Hours:**

Students will be required to complete 10 hours of volunteer work here at the school. If these hours are not completed during the school year it will drop your religion grade.
